Permits & Inspections

Every local jurisdiction is unique but you'll be in better shape if you get your inspector involved early and understand that they ensure your project is safe and secure.

Green Spaces

The pool is more than just a tank of water. The landscaping and deck are what transform it into a comfortable backyard retreat. Make sure your pool plan includes the whole backyard.

Weather Forecast

Rain and mud can slow a construction project to a crawl and cause a domino effect for builders. Keep your schedule flexible and realize that some delays are unavoidable.

Limit the number of changes to ensure your pool stays on schedule.



Consider building your pool in the fall when builders are less busy and weather is less unpredictable.
