STORING YOUR SAFETY COVER FOR

SUMMER



SIMPLE STEPS



CLEAN THE COVER

The best time to clean the cover is while it is still attached to the deck. Use a leaf blower to remove leaves, spray it clean with a hose and cleaner, brush any remaining stains with a pool brush.



RELEASE THE SPRINGS

Using the installation rod that came with your cover, unhook the springs. Put the lip of the rod on the opposite side of the anchor and twist it around to release the spring.



SCREW ANCHORS FLUSH

To prevent damage to the cover and avoid tripping, it's a good idea to screw the anchors flush soon after releasing the springs.



REMOVE THE COVER

Start at the deep end and fold the cover in sections. A good measure is from one strap distance to the next. Work towards the shallow end. Afterwards, lift it off to a clean dry surface. (Never drag the cover. Dragging can damage the cover.) Clean it thoroughly and allow it to dry.



STORING YOUR COVER

Fold the cover in half, over and over, until it is small enough to fit in the cover bag. If you don't have your cover bag, a garbage can with a lid will also work for storing the cover.



HANG THE BAG UP

It's important to keep the cover out of reach of mice and other rodents that can damage the cover.
